

Metal Coatings - Sculpt Nouveau has created special metal coatings to be used together with the patinas in order to create a metal finish. They may be used to change one metal to another or they may be applied to a non-metal surface - glass, wood, ceramics, concrete, foam, resins, and more. These coatings are made of ground metals in a water base acrylic binder. They are a durable outdoor finish that is completely non-toxic and easy to apply.

The Metal Coatings are available in three formulas – A, B, & C.

A is the original; once the coating is dry nothing else can be done to it.

B may be burnished, once dry, with steel wool in order to highlight or adjust the patina. More patina may be added after burnishing.

C is a three part mix - causing the Metal Coating to catalyze. The Metal Coating may be polished with a polishing wheel when cured.

Coverage of the Metal Coatings is 200 sq/ft per gallon -

recommended minimum of two coats

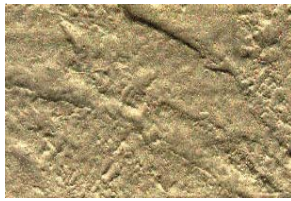

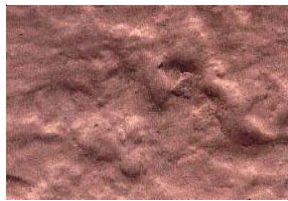
Pewter A
made from stainless steel



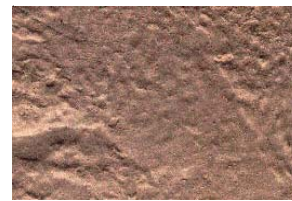
Iron A/B

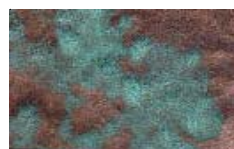
